

## **4TH BANK WINDHOEK NAMIBIA NATIONAL JUNIOR CHESS CHAMPIONSHIPS 2011 - CLOSED:**

### **1. INTRODUCTION**

The 4th Bank Windhoek Namibia National Junior Chess Championships 2011, is hosted under the auspices of the Namibia Chess Federation.

### **2. THE PURPOSE OF THIS CHESS TOURNAMENT:**

1. To determine the Namibian National Junior Champion 2011.
2. To promote chess as a sport, intellectual, educational and recreational outlet amongst the youth and the broader Namibian population.
3. To improve the standard of Junior Chess in Namibia.

### **3. VENUE:**

Windhoek at the Dawid Bezuidenhout High School—School Hall, Paul van Harte Street, Khomasdal, Windhoek.

### **4. EVENT DATE:**

22, 23 & 24 July 2011

### **5. REGISTRATION:**

## **7. SYSTEM AND RATE OF PLAY:**

The championship format will be a SWISS System tournament played over 7 (Seven Rounds) All play all and the rate of play will be 2hours 30 minutes for the entire game (1h15 minutes per player).

## **8. PAIRING AND TIE BREAK SYSTEM:**

Swiss Perfect will be used for the pairings. Please note that the breaks between rounds will be used to do the pairings according to the **SWISS SYSTEM**. TIE-BREAK, Direct encounter, Progressive Score and Median Bucholz, will be applied. If players are still tied, then 1 game of Armageddon (5 minutes for black and 6 minutes for white) will be played.

## **9. NATIONAL CHESS RATINGS:**

A chess player who does not have a national rating will receive a rating based on his/her performance against rated players.

## **10. WHO MAY PARTICIPATE?**

Only invited players. The top 6 Namibians of the 4th Bank Windhoek Namibia National Junior Chess Championships 2011 - Open. These players should be U20 according to the FIDE rules and regulations.

## **INDIVIDUAL AGE GROUP PRIZES:**

### **OVERALL**

1st Prize = N\$ 2,400.00 + Gold Medal + Trophy  
2nd Prize = N\$ 1,600.00 + Silver Medal  
3rd Prize = N\$ 1,200.00 + Bronze Medal

### **BEST GIRLS**

1st Prize = N\$ 1,800.00 + Gold Medal + Trophy  
2nd Prize = N\$ 1,200.00 + Silver Medal  
3rd Prize = N\$ 800.00 + Bronze Medal

## **12. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT:**

The participants and or their schools, organizations whom their represent will be responsible for their own accommodation, transport and meals for the duration of the event.

## **13. DRESS CODE FOR PARTICIPANTS:**

The dress code is smart casual or school uniform.

## **14. GENERAL RULES:**

1. Silence at all times.
2. Cell phones should be switch off in and outside the playing hall while the games are on. If a players cell phone rings he or she will forfeit the game.
3. Chess players should be punctual . The Zero time forfeit rule will apply in that if a player is not at the board at the start of the game he or she will forfeit the game.
4. No assistance in any form whatsoever will be allowed during the games.
5. Touch is a move, unless the touched piece has no legal moves.
6. Any player who make themselves guilty of rude behavior will be disqualified with im mediate effect.
7. Chess players should record their moves on the score sheets, provided by the LOC.
8. Chess players should bring their own pens to notate the games.
9. The Chief Arbiter will be Mr. Jossel Hindjou.
10. The LOC deserves the right to change any part of the tournament regulations to ensure a well organized event.
11. The Classical rules of FIDE will apply during this event.

## **15. LOCAL ORGANISING COMMITTEE:**

The local organizing committee are Max Nitzborn, Jossel Hindjou, Fremantle Kuhanga and Goodwill Khoa.

## **16. APPEALS COMMITTEE:**
